Where do I check in?

The convention registration area, located in Sky Bridge Registration Office, 2nd Floor, will have your name badge, event tickets, and other useful registration materials. Registration will open Tuesday, July 11, at 4 p.m. See posted hours of daily operations.

What events can I attend? How should I dress?

All delegate sessions and convention seminars are open to everyone (casual attire). If you are registered for a complete convention package, the ticketed events include: **Thursday - National Project Luncheon** (casual attire); **Friday - One Nation Under God Luncheon** (patriotic attire); **Saturday - Exchange Annual Banquet** (optional black tie for men and cocktail/formal for women).

When is Voting?

Voting will occur on Thursday, July 13, for proposed amendments at Convention Session #2; and Friday, July 14, for candidates at Convention Session #3. You can vote if your club is in good standing and your Convention Voting Credentials form is turned in by June 1. If you have any questions or concerns, please speak with staff at convention registration.
